

It's a Struggle

Instructions

Setup:

Deal out 1 Action (It's a Struggle) card and 1 Color card to each player.

Color cards are placed face up and the Action card is concealed in your hand. (If you are dealt a PLAY NOW, play the action and then redraw.) Place the two separate decks face down for draw piles.

Start:

The person wearing the most colors goes first.

Steps:

1. Draw Action card
2. Play Action card (You can play the card in your hand or the one you draw unless it says "Play now")
3. Perform action on card (If you cannot do what the Action card says then draw a Color card.)

Objective:

To win the game you need to be the last player in the game.

How to Play:

Each player takes turns drawing Action cards and performing the action.

Once someone reaches 4 of the same color they are out.

When you take or are given a Color card you place it with your other Color cards face up for everyone to see.

Action cards are played against the other players, you choose who is affected, unless the card says otherwise.

Contents: 40 color cards (Single, Double, Dual), 30 action cards
